- Assembles component parts to machine frame.
- Insert sub-assemblies into main frame.
- Learn to run cables, and hoses neatly through cable tray and raceways.

- Test the assembled machines to ensure they are functioning properly and are of good quality
- Comply with workplace health and safety policies, safe work practices, and procedures
